**Resolution No. 2019-01C**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT FOR  
LELAND BENCH UTILITIES AND RELATED MATTERS.**

WHEREAS, the Coalition has previously entered into an agreement with Uintah Advantage LLC to provide water, natural gas, and electrical utilities to a proposed specialty lube oil refinery to be constructed on Leland Bench in Uintah County, Utah; and

WHEREAS, Uintah Advantage has previously granted certain easements to the Coalition for utility rights of way between the Fort Duchesne area and Leland Bench, and

WHEREAS, the Coalition is in the process of acquiring an easement through property controlled by Don Hicken Farms, LLC that will extend the utility easement closer to a water source that is being negotiated:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Governing Board of the Seven County Infrastructure Coalition, Utah as follows:

1. The Governing Board hereby approves a right-of-way agreement between the Coalition and Don Hicken Farms, LLC, a draft of which in substantially final form is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the Board further authorizes the its Executive Director to execute and deliver the Easement Option on behalf of the Coalition in the form and with substantially the same content as set forth in Exhibit A for and on behalf of the Coalition. The Executive Director is further authorized to make any alterations, changes or additions to the Easement Option herein approved and authorized necessary to comply with comments from Don Hicken Farms, LLC, to correct errors or omissions therein, to remove ambiguities therefrom, or to conform the same to other provisions of such instruments, to the provisions of this Resolution or the provisions of the laws of the State of Utah or the United States. Execution of said documents shall conclusively establish approval of such changes.
2. Legal Counsel or other agent of the Coalition is hereby authorized to attest to all signatures and acts of any proper official of the Coalition, and to place the seal of the Coalition on the Easement Option, and any other documents authorized, necessary or proper pursuant to this Resolution or any Resolution of the Coalition. The appropriate agents of the Coalition, and each of them, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver for and on behalf of the Coalition any or all additional certificates, documents and other papers to perform all other acts they may deem necessary or appropriate in order to implement and carry out the matters authorized in this resolution and any resolution of the Coalition.




