Resolution No. 2017-10F

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COALITION TO PURSUE THE DEVELOPMENT OF RIDGE ROAD IN CARBON COUNTY, UTAH AS A PROJECT ADVANCED BY THE COALITION AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, in Carbon County, Utah there is an industrial road commonly known as Ridge Road which is in need of repair and improvement; and

WHEREAS, the repair and improvement of Ridge Road could be completed as an enterprise project, meaning a project for which charges can be made to cover the costs of repair and improvement, such as charging tolls; and

WHEREAS, Carbon County has indicated that it would approve of the Coalition advancing the repair and improvement of Ridge Road as an enterprise project; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition is willing to advance the repair and improvement of Ridge Road as an enterprise project:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Governing Board of the Seven County Infrastructure Coalition, Utah as follows:

1. The Governing Board hereby approves the repair and improvement of Ridge Road in Carbon County, Utah if it can be completed as an enterprise project in a fashion agreeable to Carbon County. The Board directs the Executive Director to explore the viability of the Ridge Road project as an enterprise project and to report the findings to the Board and the Carbon County Commission when ready.
2. All parts of this Resolution are severable, and if any section, clause or provision of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, clauses or provisions of this Resolution.
3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval and adoption
