Resolution No. 2021-04G

RESOLUTION APPROVING A LETTER OPPOSING BAN ON FRACKING AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, certain interests have sent letters to the White House asking the President of the United States to issue an order to ban fracking in 2025; and

WHEREAS, a ban on fracking would have multiple negative consequences on the Seven County Infrastructure Coalition and on its member counties; and

WHEREAS, other public bodies and elected officials intend to send letters to the President of the United States to oppose a ban on fracking; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition Board desires to authorize a letter to be sent to the President of the United States to opposing a ban on fracking and explaining the detrimental impacts that would certainly result from a ban:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Governing Board of the Seven County Infrastructure Coalition, Utah as follows:

1. The Governing Board hereby authorizes and approves a letter to be signed by the Co-Chairs and Executive Director directed to the President of the United States to oppose a ban on fracking and related matters and the Board directs the Executive Director to complete such letter and once it is fully executed to send it by itself or along with other such letters, to the President of the United States and to the elected members of the federal delegation for the State of Utah.
2. All parts of this Resolution are severable, and if any section, clause or provision of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, clauses or provisions of this Resolution.
3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval and adoption




