Information We Collect

1. Google Analytics Data

Our website utilizes Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics collects various types of data to analyze and track website traffic and usage patterns. Importantly, we do not collect any personal information directly through our website. The information collected by Google Analytics may include:

User Interaction Data: Details about users' interactions with our website, such as page views, clicks, and time spent on each page.

Device Information: Information about the device used to access our website, including the device type, operating system, browser type, and screen resolution.

IP Addresses: Google Analytics may capture users' IP addresses, which are anonymized to protect user privacy.

Geographic Location: Inferred geographic locations based on users' IP addresses, providing aggregated data about the geographic distribution of website visitors.

Referral Sources: Information about how users arrive at our website, such as referral URLs, search engine queries, or direct traffic.

2. Cookies

Google Analytics uses cookies, which are small text files stored on users' devices, to collect data about website usage. These cookies enable Google Analytics to distinguish unique visitors, track user sessions, and gather information about user behavior on our website.

Keeping Your Information Secure

The safety of any data that you provide is our priority. We have taken adequate measures to protect it. Here's how we ensure your data stays safe: We do not share contact information.

The data collected through Google Analytics is aggregated and anonymized before being processed for analytical purposes. This means that individual users cannot be identified from the data collected by Google Analytics.

Data Ownership and Control

While we have access to the aggregated data provided by Google Analytics, we do not have direct control over the data collected by Google. Users can manage their preferences regarding Google Analytics data collection by adjusting their browser settings or opting out of Google Analytics tracking using the Google Analytics Opt-Out Browser Add-on.

Usage of Collected Data

The data collected by Google Analytics is used solely to analyze website traffic, understand user behavior, and optimize our website to better serve our users. We do not use Google Analytics data for any other purpose, and we do not share this data with third parties.
